## ORDER

On November 20, 2008, the Court granted Petitioner's Motion to Stay and directed the Clerk to administratively close the case pending disposition of <u>Gatewood v. T. C. Outlaw</u>, CA 08-2197. The Eighth Circuit has since rendered its decision in that case, 2009 WL 775567 (8th Cir. Mar. 26, 2009), and Petitioner now moves to lift the stay and reopen his case. He further moves to withdraw his habeas petition without prejudice, despite the fact that his counsel will seek review by the United States Supreme Court of the Gatewood decision.
