

check or money orders are to be made payable to Social Security Administration, Debt Management Section, Attn: Court Refund, P.O. Box 2861, Philadelphia, PA 19122.

3. That the defendant shall submit to the United States for review on at least an annual basis a statement of his financial condition and that such information shall be grounds to increase the payments of the defendant to the plaintiff at that time.

4. The Judgment shall be filed with the federal clerk of the county of residence of the defendant and any other jurisdiction where the United States deems appropriate.

5. In the event the defendant defaults in the payment of any installment due under this order, upon application by the United States after notice to the defendant, an execution shall be issued by the Clerk for the full amount of the indebtedness certified to be due and outstanding.

6. Notice to the defendant pursuant to Paragraph 5 above shall be deemed due and sufficient notice if sent by first class mail, postage prepaid to the defendant, Julie Newton at least ten (10) days prior to the issuance of such execution.
