## ORDER

Opposed recommendation,  $N_{P}$  7, adopted as supplemented. FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b)(3). Whitehead also says that Campbell, who is not listed as a defendant, knew of the trouble he was having with his finger,  $N_{P}$  5 at 5; but Whitehead doesn't allege that Campbell was personally involved with his treatment. Whitehead's claims against Horton, Griffith, Obi, and Campbell are dismissed without prejudice for failure to state a claim. Whitehead's deliberate -indifference claim against Simmons remains. Ray Griffith and Ray Gruff are the same person. The Court therefore directs the Clerk to terminate Ray Gruff as a defendant. The Court certifies that an *in forma pauperis* appeal from this Order would not be taken in good faith. So Ordered.
