ORDER

¹In Plaintiff's objections, Plaintiff asks that the "names signed to the grievances" be added to his claims. Plaintiff fails to allege how each personally violated his rights. Further, a prison official's denial of grievances is insufficient to impose liability under § 1983. *See Rowe v. Norris*, 198 Fed. Appx. 579(8th Cir.2006). Accordingly, Plaintiff's request is denied.
