ORDER

Robinson appeals Magistrate Judge Deere's Order requiring him to pay the \$400 filing and administrative fees in order to proceed with this case. *No. 7*. Magistrate Judge Deere didn't clearly err or misapply the law. Several higher courts have held that the three-strikes provision is constitutional. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g); *Higgins v. Carpenter*, 258 F.3d 797, 800-01 (8th Cir. 2001) (*per curiam*); *Lewis v. Sullivan*, 279 F.3d 526 (7th Cir. 2002) (collecting cases). Robinson's appeal, *No. 7*, is therefore denied. FED. R. CIV. P. 72(a).
