ORDER

1. On *de novo* review, the Court adopts Magistrate Judge Harris's partial recommendation, $N_{\mathbb{0}}$ 40, and overrules Dunahue's objections, $N_{\mathbb{0}}$ 44 & $N_{\mathbb{0}}$ 48–49. FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b)(3). The issue at this stage isn't whether Dunahue should win on his underlying claims; it's whether he's cleared the high bar required to get preliminary injunctive relief. He hasn't. His motions, $N_{\mathbb{0}}$ 6 & $N_{\mathbb{0}}$ 26, are therefore denied.

2. The Court cautions Dunahue: in his future filings, he must speak with courtesy and respect.
