
ORDER

On June 22, 2010, the court entered an Order and Judgment reversing the decision of the Commissioner and remanding the case for further proceedings. Plaintiff has filed a motion for attorney's fees and expenses pursuant to the Equal Access to Justice Act (EAJA), 28 U.S.C. § 2412. He seeks compensation for 42.85 hours of work performed by his attorney at a rate of \$175.02 per hour and for expenses in the amount of \$52.46. The Commissioner filed a Response, stating that the parties have agreed to an attorney's fee award of \$6,000, and that he does not object to the amount of expenses.¹

Accordingly, the court grants Plaintiff compensation of \$6,000 in attorney's fees. The court also grants Plaintiff's request for expenses in the amount of \$52.46.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Plaintiff is awarded attorney's fees in the amount of \$6,000, together with expenses in the amount of \$52.46, for a total of \$6,052.46. The Commissioner is directed to certify said award and pay Plaintiff's attorney in this amount.
