ORDER

Plaintiff commenced this *pro se* § 1983 action while he was confined in the Crittenden County Detention Facility ("CCDF"). *See* docket entry #2. On July 17, 2009, mail addressed to Plaintiff at the CCDF was returned as undeliverable because he has been released from custody. *See* docket entry #21. In light of his recent release, it is unclear whether Plaintiff remains interested in pursuing this action and, if so, whether he is still entitled to proceed *in forma pauperis*. Accordingly, the Court will give Plaintiff thirty days to file: (1) a Statement indicating whether he wishes to continue with this action; and (2) an Amended (freeworld) Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis*.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send Petitioner a (freeworld) Amended Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis*.

2. Plaintiff shall file, **within thirty days of the entry of this Order**: (a) a Statement indicating whether he wishes to continue with this lawsuit; and (b) an Amended Application to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis*.

3. Plaintiff is reminded that the failure to timely and properly comply with this Order could result in the dismissal of this case, without prejudice, pursuant to Local Rule 5.5(c)(2).
