<u>ORDER</u>

Plaintiff Nicholas Cortez Addison ("Addison") commenced the case at bar by filing

a complaint pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 1983. In the complaint, he alleged the following:

On 6-4-15, Joey Martin violated my constitutional rights and attreymorptsedptolibrioge apperby ortel, lihit here, yand broutonies, (Tristen Addison) come back to the detox center with you." When I asked Joey Martin what paperwork, he said, "lawsuits." I replied I have the right to file anything I want if I feel my rights have been violated. It's now Monday 6-7-15, [and] my brother is still not here with me.

See Document 2 at CM/ ECF 4.

Addison has now filed a motion for discovery and for trial date. See Document 39.

In the motion, he asks for a "Freedom of Information Act and a motion for discovery

[and] ... a court date and speedy trial." See Document 39 at CW ECF 1.

The motion is denied. Addison's requests for discovery should be directed to

defendant Joey Martin and should specify the documents Addison is seeking. A court/trial date will be scheduled forthwith if the Court determines that a trial is necessary.
