ORDER

Unopposed recommendation, *No 6*, adopted as modified. FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b) (1983 Addition to Advisory Committee Notes). Addison asks what the procedure is for paying the filing fee. *No 7 at 2*. But paying the filing fee would be pointless because Addison's complaint fails to state a claim. Addison cannot recover money promised as a bribe. *E.g., Kansas City Operating Corp. v. Durwood*, 278 F.2d 354, 358 (8th Cir. 1960); *No 2 at 4-6*. Addison's complaint will be dismissed without prejudice. This dismissal counts as another "strike" for purposes of 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g). An *in forma pauperis* appeal from this Order and accompanying Judgment would not be taken in good faith.
