ORDER

Addison moves to proceed *in forma pauperis* in this § 1983 case; but he is a three-striker. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g). Before filing this lawsuit, Addison had at least five cases dismissed for failing to state a claim. *E.g., Addison v. Martin,* 3:15-cv-1-JM; *Addison v. Martin,* 3:15-cv-91-DPM; *Addison v. Martin,* 3:15-cv-96-DPM; *Addison v. Doe,* 3:15-cv-121-DPM; and *Addison v. Muse,* 3:15-cv-133-JM. And nothing in the complaint suggests that he's in imminent danger of serious physical injury. *Ibid.* His application to proceed *in forma pauperis,* N_{e} 1, is therefore denied.

Addison's complaint will be dismissed without prejudice. An *in forma pauperis* appeal from this Order and accompanying Judgment will not be taken in good faith. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3). If Addison wants to pursue this

case, then he must pay \$400.00 (the filing fee and administrative fees) and file a motion to reopen the case by 15 October 2015.
