ORDER

Plaintiff Nicholas Addison's motion for a jury trial [Doc. No. 18] is denied as moot because this case is closed.

Ark. 2015) (dismissed for the failure to state a claim); *Addison v. Martin, et al.*, Case. No. 3:15-CV-00091 DPM (E.D. Ark. 2015) (dismissed for the failure to state a claim); *Addison v. Martin, et al.*, Case. No. 3:15-CV-00091 DPM (E.D. Ark. 2015) (dismissed for the failure to state a claim); *Addison v. Martin, et al.*, Case. No. 3:15-CV-00091 DPM (E.D. Ark. 2015) (dismissed for the failure to state a claim). Recently, he began filing motions demanding trials in cases that have already been closed.
