Judge Ron Hunter violated prisoners 8th amendment for assesial bonds given us bonds that we cannot make and keeping us prisoners in Jails. Some of us can't afford to make \$100,000 Cash bonds. We thought that bonds were supposed to ^{make sure we go} ~~keep us to going to~~ Court. The court is keeping us in the County anywhere from 6 to 9 months before giving us any deals. They don't even come talk to the prisoners. And the courts won't acknowledge our Bond Reductions.

until the court date. You don't even have a right in your own defense. The judge Barbara Hozly & the prosecutors and our public defenders. They offer people on drugs penitentiary time instead of sending them to rehab. And they say that the prisons are way to full ~~to send us~~ but they still want to send us. They scare prisoners to take a offer, either that or trial. And when a charge is not that big, the courts is very racist towards the blacks. And they talk to us prisoners in the library while monitors is on the wall, so the dispatchers can easily hear us. And I thought the things me and my lawyer was supposed to be private. Bryan Miles & Curtis Tate the investigator, are playing good cop bad cop. I had already given Brian Miles a written statement. Him Bryan Miles & Tate gave a recorded statement to me in the library and violated my constitution rights as well. I was not on my medication Seri-quit and had to see midSouth. While he was trying to get a recorded statement from me because he said it's better to do it this way, while the monitors is on the wall, to be heard from 911 dispatch. He refuses to give me my writing statement and my photographs of motion of discoveries. And all the rest of the information. They keep all prisoners in the dark so they can't get the write to defend themselves. And we all prisoners scared due to retaliation for signing and sticking together.



As a result of this finding, there is insufficient cause to proceed and this complaint is dismissed. On July 12, 2016 at approximately 4:20 p.m., I received a call at my home from the on duty dispatcher, Robin Cavvit, that a shooting had taken place in Brauer Estates. Chief Lung, Sgt Boykin and Officers Simmons and Fox were already in service and at the scene of the shooting, 130 Elder Street, Apt. 9. Capt Holt was notified and also responded. As information started becoming available, it was learned that "Cyrus" (Quincrus Bettes) and "Lil T" (Terry Wofford), both juveniles, were seen running from the apartment of the shooting. A grid search was initiated to try and locate the two as well as a third person who had been identified as "Nick" (Nicholas) Addison. During the search, Sgt Boykin located Bettes and Wofford at the intersection of Wylie and Lindsey Streets. Both were transported to the Marked Tree Police Department for questioning. Both were separated as we waited for the arrival of their parents. The parents of Bettes and Wofford, Virginia Hughes and Terry Lee Wofford respectively, were notified and came to the police station. Bettes was advised of his juvenile Miranda rights and he and his mother signed a rights form acknowledging their understanding of the rights. Bettes stated that on this date he, Terry Wofford, Nicholas Addison and another person whom he only knew as "Quan", later identified as Marquan Orlando Sain, were at apartment 9D, leased to Caitlin Thomas, Thomas was not at the apartment at the time of the shooting. Bettes went on to state that they were "smoking weed" and at some point, Addison called the victim, Dustin Rose, and told him to come to the apartment. A short time later, Rose arrived and Addison, Bettes and Wofford went into the bedroom. Bettes alleges that Addison was upset at Rose because he owed him money for a cell phone. Rose allegedly stated that he did not have the money and that 'I know not to mess with you Nick.' At that point, Rose called his brother, Ryan Rose, and asked if he could bring the money to him so that he could pay Addison. Ryan Rose told him that he was not coming and that he (Dustin) needed to handle his business (Ryan Rose verified this phone call and the statements made between he and his brother to me via telephone on July 13, 2016). When Addison learned that Rose's brother was not bringing the money, Bettes alleges that Addison became agitated and began to hit Rose. Addison then pulled a gun from his waistband and struck Rose in the head with it and 'it just went off.' Bettes then states that Addison pulled a knife and was going to 'cut Rose's throat.' Addison then stuck the knife into Rose's face cutting him severely. Addison then stated, 'might as well finish him, he's gonna die anyway.' Bettes states that he and Wofford were afraid and tried to leave. Addison told them that they couldn't leave and began to clean the crime scene with bleach and water. As he was cleaning, he told both Bettes and Wofford that if they talked to the police, 'I will come for you. I know how to get you!' Rose then stated, 'Please Nick, call me an ambulance. I'll say that I shot myself and that it was an accident.' Addison ignored him and continued to clean the crime scene. Bettes completed a written statement which was witnessed by his mother.

Wofford was then questioned with his father present. Wofford was advised of his juvenile Miranda rights and he and his father signed a rights form acknowledging their understanding of the rights. Wofford was not forthcoming in his initial interview. He first stated that he and Bettes had stopped by the apartment and briefly spoke to Addison and had left. He went on to state he knew nothing of the shooting until he was detained by Sgt Boykin. On the second rendition of his account, he stated that he was in the house but he was sitting in the living room and did not see what happened in the room but that he heard the shot. When questioned for the third time, Wofford started crying and related a statement which corroborated Bettes's account of what happened in the bedroom. Wofford admitted to being in the room at the time of the shooting. Wofford completed a written statement which was witnessed by his father.

At approximately 8:23 p.m., we received a call stating that Addison was in Trumann, AR. Capt Holt, Sgt Boykin and myself went to the Trumann Police Department where we were met by several Poinsett County Sheriff's deputies. Just as we arrived, the sheriff's dispatcher radioed and stated that Addison's cell phone had been pinged and that the location had been identified. All officers responded from the Trumann Police Department to 17716 Hwy 163 N in Trumann, AR. With the house surrounded, Sheriff's deputies knocked on the door. After several minutes, Addison, along with another male and two females emerged from the residence. All four were handcuffed and searched. I advised Addison of his Miranda rights which was recorded via Sgt Boykin's Axon Body Cam. Addison acknowledged his rights but asked for an attorney at the onset of me asking him questions. After requesting a lawyer, I advised Addison that I could no longer talk to him. Addison made a spontaneous utterance, after being advised of rights, stating, "you ain't got nothin'. You didn't find any shell casings." I advised Addison again that he needed to exercise his right to remain silent and speak to an attorney.

Addison was transported to the Marked Tree jail where he was charged with Criminal Conspiracy-Class A Felony (Attempted Murder), Tampering with Evidence, Intimidation of a Witness (x2), Kidnapping (false imprisonment) and Hindering Apprehension or Prosecution. Addison was fingerprinted, DNA swabbed and administered a GSR (gunshot residue test). He is being held in the Marked Tree jail awaiting a Probable Cause Hearing on July 14, 2016.

SUPPLEMENTAL ENTRY:

On July 14, 2016 at approximately 11:00 a.m., I interviewed Dustin Rose in his hospital bed at Regional One Medical Center in Memphis, TN. In a recorded statement (Rose was unable to write due to medical instruments attached to his hand) that it

was Terry Wofford who shot him while he was being held on the floor at knife point by Addison. Rose went on to state that Addison, Wofford, Bettes and Sain were all in the room when he was shot. Rose also stated that the four "spun him around on the floor" while he was on his back. Rose was being kicked in his head and face along with being punched in the arm and chest area. With Addison holding a knife to his throat and clinching Rose's shirt in the collar area with his other hand, Wofford stood over Rose and shot him once in the chest at point blank range. After speaking with Rose, I notified Marked Tree Dispatch to have officers arrest Wofford, Bettes and Sain. All three were located, taken into custody and transported to the Marked Tree Jail. Terry Lee Wofford and Virginia Hughes, parents of Wofford and Bettes (respectively) were notified and were at the police station upon my arrival.

Terry Wofford; In a Body Cam recorded interview and via written statement with his father present, Wofford confessed to shooting Rose. Both statements, recorded and written, corroborated Rose's recorded interview. Wofford stated that Bettes first held the gun to Rose's head but that Bettes was afraid to shoot Rose. Wofford then took the gun from Bettes, stood over Rose and shot him once in the chest. When asked why he shot Rose, Wofford responded, "I just wanted to be a cool kid." When asked what he did after shooting Rose, Wofford replied, "I just went in the living room and sat down. Then Nick (Addison) grabbed a mop and started cleaning up." Wofford stated that he, Bettes, Sain and Addison were in the room at the time of the shooting. When asked where the gun was, Wofford stated he didn't know but that the gun belonged to Sain.

Quincrus Bettes: In a Body Cam recorded interview and via written statement with his mother present, Bettes stated that he in fact held the gun to Rose's head but was afraid to shoot him because "I didn't want to go to jail for murder." Bettes went on to state that he witnessed Wofford shoot Rose as Addison was holding Rose down on the floor with a knife to his throat. When asked what happened next, Bettes stated, "we just went in the living room." Bettes stated that he, Wofford, Sain and Addison were in the room at the time of the shooting. When asked where the gun was, Bettes stated that the gun belonged to Sain and that he had hid it "in a black duffel bag at Lil T's (Wofford) grandma's house." Bettes went on to state that the bag was located in the last bedroom on the left at 705 Lindsey Street, Marked Tree, AR. Bettes stated he saw Sain hide it in the duffel bag the day of the shooting, July 12, 2016.

Marquan Sain: In a Body Cam recorded interview, Sain refused to cooperate. Sain continued to state that he never brought a gun to the scene and that he didn't know where it had come from. Sain also stated that he was never in the room but that he stayed in the living room during the events that unfolded. When told that the other arrestees had told us where to find the gun, he continued to deny involvement. A subsequent search was conducted at 705 Lindsey St. Marked Tree, AR with the consent of the owner, Johnny L Wofford. The owner showed myself and Officers Rains and Fox to the room where Sain slept in and which articles of luggage belonged to Sain. The owner assured us that no one in the house had been in the bedroom since the arrest of Sain and Wofford earlier that day. The lower receiver of the gun, a stolen S/W .40 semi automatic pistol (serial #DWE9881), was found in a pocket in a pair of white jeans belonging to Sain. The slide and barrel were found in a pair of Nike gym shoes belonging to Sain. The magazine was found in another gym shoe belonging to Sain. A box of .40 caliber ammunition was found in a purple Crown Royal bag which was inside of the pocket of Sain's black duffel bag.

An ACIC check of the gun's serial number confirmed that the gun was stolen out of Houston, TX in 2011. A request for the theft report from Houston, PD was requested.
