

ORDER

²Petitioner is hereby notified of his responsibility to comply with the Local Rules of the Court including Rule 5.5(c)(2), which states:

It is the duty of any party not represented by Local Rules of the United States District Court for the Eastern and Western Districts of Arkansas counsel to promptly notify the Clerk and the other parties to the proceedings of any change in his or her address, to monitor the progress of the case, and to prosecute or defend the action diligently.
