**ORDER**


The Court has received Proposed Findings and Recommendations from Magistrate Judge Jerome T. Kearney (Dkt. No. 6). 3. The Court certifies that an *in forma pauperis* appeal from this Order and Judgment would not be taken in good faith, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3).
