ORDER

1. Adams's motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*, No 1, is granted. He can't afford the filing fee and has no income.

He says many things, but none of them amount to a claim that this Court can address. *Denton v. Hernandez*, 504 U.S. 25, 32-33 (1992). 3. His motion for appointed counsel, No 3, is denied as moot.
