**ORDER**

1. Counts I, IV, V, and VII of Centennial's second amended complaint, *No* 37, are dismissed without prejudice. Counts II, III, VI, VIII, and IX will go to trial on 10 December 2018.

2. For the reasons stated on the record at the 26 November 2018 hearing, the Court made the following rulings on the evidentiary issues:

- Centennial's motions *in limine*, *No* 169 & 174, are partly granted and partly denied, with caveats;
- Centennial's motion to take judicial notice, *No* 176, is granted on the two caregiver orders and otherwise denied. The Court will give a limiting instruction; and
- Wood's motion *in limine*, *No* 171, is partly granted and partly denied, with caveats.
