## **ORDER**

The Court dismissed Erwin's case on 9 March 2018. He's continued to file new materials, though. Recently, Erwin filed another complaint, which he titled as a "new case or amend[ment]."  $N_{\rm P}$  6 at 1. It involves events that occurred after his first complaint was dismissed. See, e.g.  $N_{\rm P}$  6 at 6. This proposed pleading is a new case. Erwin's request to file this amendment as a new case,  $N_{\rm P}$  6 at 1 & 8, is tentatively granted. The Court directs the Clerk to file  $N_{\rm P}$  6 as a complaint, assign it a case number, and assign it at random to a judge. The Court also directs the Clerk to mail Erwin an *in forma pauperis* form with a copy of this Order. Erwin must complete and file the form by 1 May 2018. Thereafter, the assigned judge will screen the new case.
