ORDER

- 1. On *de novo* review, the Court partly adopts and partly declines without prejudice the recommendation, № 11. FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b)(3). The Court has reviewed every one of Griffin's filings. Notwithstanding her frustrations, she hasn't alleged facts to support a claim for deliberate indifference by the named individual defendants. And she can't raise claims on others' behalf.
- **2.** The Court partly sustains Griffin's objections, N_{0} 13, N_{0} 14, & N_{0} 15. Griffin talks about amendment and, in her recent filings, she's alleged some facts that may state a claim against Officer Johnson, Mrs. Stokes, and Mrs. Williams. *E.g.*, N_{0} 13. The Court therefore returns Griffin's case to the Magistrate Judge for further development, including re-pleading and screening.
