ORDER

On January 14, 2025, Plaintiff Scott Landon Pitts notified the Court that he has been released from incarceration and is receiving mail through a P.O. Box in Harrisburg, Arkansas. (Doc. 4). If Plaintiff wishes to pursue this lawsuit, he must file an updated *in forma pauperis* motion ("IFP Motion") that reflects his free-world financial status or pay the \$405 filing and administrative fees, in full.¹

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Clerk is directed to mail Plaintiff a free-world IFP Motion.
- 2. If Plaintiff wishes to pursue this lawsuit, then, within thirty (30) days of this Order, he must either: (a) file a completed free-world IFP Motion; or (b) pay the \$405 filing and administrative fees owed for this action. If he does not comply with this Order, this case will be dismissed, without prejudice, pursuant to LOCAL RULE 5.5(c)(2).

¹ According to Clerk's records, no portion of the filing fee was collected from Plaintiff's institutional account while he was incarcerated. (*See* Doc. 3) (directing that monthly payments be collected and remitted to the Clerk).
