ORDER

Pending is Defendants’ Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc. No. 27). Plaintiff has responded.¹

Defendants contend that they are entitled to summary judgment because Plaintiff, in her fact sheet, did “*not* contend that she experience the basic symptoms of menopause,” and, therefore “no expert can reliably rule out the role of *Plaintiff’s* endogenous estrogen” in causing her breast cancer.² In response, Plaintiff points out that her fact sheet listed “[f]atigue and temperature changes,’ both recognized symptoms of menopause.”³

Accordingly, Defendants’ Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc. No. 27) is DENIED.
