A mail clerk who was fired by Ohio Republican Sen. Mike DeWine for using office computers to post an Internet sex diary is being paid in the "substantial six figures" for a novel based on her exploits, The New York Times reported last week.

The newspaper said former DeWine employee Jessica Cutler will write a book called "The **Washingtonienne**" for **HyperionDisney**, and pose nude for the November issue of Playboy.

The Web site operator who first drew attention to Cutler's online diary, "Wonkette.com," said the book sold for \$300,000.

Cutler's diary, or "blog," chronicled affairs with six unnamed men, including one she described as the married chief-of-staff of a federal agency. It also discussed being paid for sex.

"Most of my living expenses are thankfully subsidized by a few generous older gentlemen," she said on the blog, called "The **Washingtonienne**." "I'm sure I am not the only one who makes money this way: how can anybody live on \$25K/year??"



Internet sex diarist Jessica Cutler -- known in the U.S. capital by her nom de plume "**Washingtonienne**" -- has signed a lucrative book deal with **HyperionDisney** to write a novel, the company said Thursday.

The publishing house declined to disclose the amount of the book deal, but her agent, Michael Carlisle, told The New York Times that the price was in the "substantial six figures."

Washington's internet gossip column "Wonkette" reported Thursday that the book contract with Hyperion went for \$300,000.

Cutler was dismissed in May from her entry-level job sorting mail in the office of Republican Sen. Mike DeWine of Ohio after using congressional computers to post her lovemaking exploits on her Internet blog.


Her jauntily written e-diary included descriptions of sexual encounters on Capitol Hill and other venues in official Washington -- some allegedly involving prominent but unnamed paramours, including an unidentified Bush administration appointee.

The frank accounts, which became "must-reads" in Washington, included descriptions of sexual favors for money, which she said she needed to supplement her \$25,000-per-year paycheck.

According to the Times, which wrote that the novel would be called "**Washingtonienne**," after its author, Cutler also has agreed to pose nude for the November 2004 issue of Playboy.

First the scandal. Next, the book.

Jessica Cutler, the Nottingham High School graduate who recently captivated the Beltway with an online diary of her sexual trysts in the nation's capital, this week signed a book deal with **HyperionDisney**, her literary agent said Thursday.

"It's a great six-figure deal," said Pilar Queen, an agent at Carlisle & Co. in New York.

Queen also said Cutler, who attended Syracuse University, plans to pose nude for the November issue of Playboy.

Cutler, 26, was fired in May from her \$25,000-a-year job as a staff assistant in the Washington office of Sen. Mike DeWine, R-Ohio, for inappropriate use of office equipment. She apparently used government computers to update her Web log, which described encounters with six sex partners identified only by their initials. She wrote that one federal agency chief of staff paid her \$400 for sex.

Her book, a novel, will be titled "**Washingtonienne**," after the now-infamous blog.

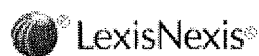

Washington sex blogger signs book deal

Washington sex blogger Jessica Cutler - aka Washingtonienne - has reportedly signed a \$300,000 book deal with HyperionDisney.

Cutler formerly worked sorting mail for Republican Senator Mike DeWine but was shown the door after using Congressional computers to write her now-legendary blog. The diaries recount Washingtonienne's sexual shenanigans on Capitol Hill, including fumbblings with an unnamed Bush administration appointee. She also apparently sold herself like a two-bit hussy to supplement her meagre \$25k salary.

Cutler's agent told the *New York Times* that the book deal was in the "substantial six figures." [Wonkette.com](http://www.wonkette.com/) (<http://www.wonkette.com/>) is a little more forthcoming, noting:

About that Washingtonienne book deal: We hear the bidding started Tuesday at \$75K, based on a 25 page proposal (described a "pretty f***ing twisted"). A dozen houses went for it, and she wound up with a cool \$300-f***ing-000.

And she still owes us for drinks!

Cutler will also pose for the November issue of *Playboy*, according to the *NYT*. No more cut-price sexual favours between sorting mail for this go-ahead girl, it's clear. ®
