
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Separate Defendant Arkansas Department of Correction is DISMISSED, WITH PREJUDICE.
2. Separate Defendant Correctional Medical Services, Inc., is DISMISSED, WITHOUT PREJUDICE.
3. The Clerk is directed to prepare a summons for Defendants Lieutenant Crumpton, Corporal Ivy, Corporal T. Sanders, Sergeant H. Williams, Corporal Butler, and Corporal A. Stewart. The United States Marshal is directed to serve the summons, the Complaint and Amended Complaint (docket entries #2 and #8), the Recommended Partial Disposition, and this Order on those six

Defendants through the ADC Compliance Division, without prepayment of fees and costs or security therefor.<sup>1</sup>

4. The Clerk is directed to prepare a summons for Defendants Nurses Glass and Lewis. The United States Marshal is directed to serve the summons, the Complaint and Amended Complaint (docket entries #2 and #8), the Recommended Partial Disposition, and this Order on those two Defendants through the Humphries and Lewis law firm, without prepayment of fees and costs or security therefor.<sup>2</sup>
