

ORDER

The Court was curious about why Coles had neither responded to Baptist's motion to dismiss nor replied to Baptist's response in opposition to his motion for summary judgment. In light of this confusion, Coles has until 6 January 2012 to respond to the motion to dismiss, *Document No. 47*, and reply to the response to his motion for summary judgment, *Document No. 49*.

The Court also received Baptist Health's request for a hearing on the pending motions via the attached letter. The Court will wait to see if and how Coles responds and will review the papers before determining if a hearing is necessary.
