**ORDER** 

Plaintiff originally filed this action on August 2, 2011 (Doc. No. 2). The Court notes that

provide a present address on Defendants Johnson and Nelson within thirty days of the date of this

Order. Failure to provide such or obtain service on these Defendants shall result in the dismissal of

Plaintiff's Complaint, without prejudice.
