AMENDED JUDGMENT

1. On count I of the United States' counterclaim, the Court enters judgment for the United States against Ralph Bradbury for \$823,166.18, as of 13 November 2014, plus any statutory additions accruing after that date according to law until the amount owed is paid in full. 26 U.S.C. §§ 6601(a), 6621(a)(2) & 6622(a); 28 U.S.C. § 1961(c)(1).¹ Count I of Bradbury's second amended complaint is dismissed with prejudice.

2. By stipulation between Bradbury and the United States, count II of

Bradbury's second amended complaint, and count II of the United States' counterclaim, are dismissed with prejudice.

3. Count III of the United States' counterclaim, which runs solely against Rick Acklin, is dismissed with prejudice. Acklin's claims against the United States are dismissed with prejudice.
