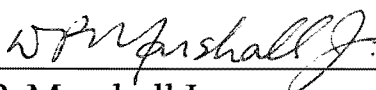

ORDER

HCA-Information Technology & Services, Inc., registered a judgment, *Document No. 1*, and applied for writs of garnishment and execution. The Clerk issued both, *Document Nos. 2 & 3*.
