ORDER

Plaintiff Frederick Banks filed his complaint on July 5, 2013, in the United States District Court for the Middle District of Pennsylvania (Dkt. No. 1). On August 8, 2013, the United States District Court for the Middle District of Pennsylvania transferred the case to this Court

with the Court showing excusable neglect. Therefore, this action is dismissed without prejudice.
