## **ORDER**

Rosario says Velez tricked him into investing his 401k money with Velez, who then ran off with the funds.  $N_2$  3. The case was filed in Texas, but transferred here because venue there was bad.  $N_2$  6. Rosario and Velez both live in Arkansas, and everything Rosario alleges happened took place in Arkansas too. The transfer cured the venue problem, but it didn't fix the jurisdictional one: there's no diversity, and no federal law is implicated. 28 U.S.C. §§ 1331 & 1332. Rosario's complaint is therefore dismissed without prejudice for lack of subject matter jurisdiction. He must proceed in an Arkansas court. The IFP motion,  $N_2$  5, is denied as moot.
