ORDER

Plaintiff Coulter has removed her case, which was pending in the Arkansas Court of Appeals. *No 2*. She may not do this for several reasons. Perhaps most importantly, the right of removal now belongs only to “the defendant or the defendants. . . .” 28 U.S.C. § 1441(a); *see generally, Shamrock Oil & Gas Corp. v. Sheets*, 313 U.S. 100, 104–06 (1941) (history and changing terms of the removal statute). Motion, *No 1*, denied as moot. Case remanded. The Clerk shall send a certified copy of this Order to Leslie Steen, the Clerk of the Arkansas Supreme Court and the Arkansas Court of Appeals, and a copy to all persons listed in Coulter’s certificate of service, *No 2 at 11*.
