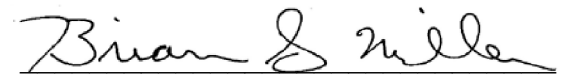

ORDER

The partial recommended disposition submitted by United States Magistrate Judge Joe J. Volpe has been received, along with the objections thereto.
