## **ORDER**

Motion to dismiss,  $N_2$  5, granted without prejudice to a post-discovery proposed amendment that pleads fraudulent concealment with particularity. Summerhill v. Terminix, Inc., 2009 WL 3380713, \*3–4 (E.D. Ark.); FED. R. CIV. P. 9(b). For now, Walker's claims are bounded by the applicable limitation periods.
