ORDER

1. Unopposed recommendation, *No 19*, adopted. FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b) (1983 addition to advisory committee notes). Defendants' motion to dismiss, *No 14*, is granted in part and denied in part without prejudice.

2. Curtis's claim for declaratory relief for other people, and his official capacity claims for monetary relief, are dismissed with prejudice.

3. Curtis's constitutional claim about crediting meritorious good time
