ORDER

The Court screened Arnold's complaint and ordered her to re-plead by 13 November 2015. *No. 5*. The Court told Arnold that if she didn't file an amended complaint by that date, her case would be dismissed without prejudice. Arnold then asked me to recuse. *No. 8*. The Court held a hearing on her motion. *No. 9*. Arnold didn't appear or file any paper saying why she didn't come to the hearing. In the meantime, her deadline to re-plead had passed. The Court denied Arnold's recusal motion but gave her more time to amend her complaint. *No. 11*. That deadline, 2 December 2015, has passed too. Arnold still has not amended her deficient complaint. This case will therefore be dismissed without prejudice.
