ORDER

The Court has received a Partial Recommended Disposition (“Recommendation”) from Magistrate Judge Beth Deere. After careful review of the Recommendation, Mr. Phillips’s timely objections,¹ as well as a *de novo* review of the record, the Court concludes that the Recommendation should be, and hereby is, approved and adopted as this Court’s findings in all respects.

Mr. Phillips’s verbal harassment and retaliation claims are **DISMISSED**, without prejudice. In addition, his claims against Defendant Holliday are **DISMISSED**, without prejudice, and the Clerk of the Court is instructed to terminate Sheriff Holliday as a party Defendant. Finally, Mr. Phillips’s claims against Defendant Williams in his official capacity are **DISMISSED**, without prejudice.
