

Company, 517 F.3d 526, 531 (8th Cir.2008), the insurance company is entitled to judgment as a matter of law.

Liberty Mutual's policy defines relatives who live in the home as insureds. *No 12-1 at 9*. And it doesn't cover bodily injury to any insured. *No 12-1 at 21*. That's what happened when Garrett injured his step-father with brass knuckles. There's no coverage. Motion for summary judgment, *No 10*, granted.
