ORDER

Pending is Plaintiff's Application for Attorney's Fees pursuant to the Equal Access to Justice Act (EAJA), 28 U.S.C. § 2412 (Doc. No. 13). Defendant does not object.¹

Since the hours spent by counsel were reasonable, the motion is GRANTED and Plaintiff is entitled to attorney's fees and costs in the amount of \$3,088.54 (17.5 attorney hours at \$175.00/hour; and costs totaling \$26.04).²

The EAJA fee award is payable to Plaintiff and mailed to Plaintiff's counsel, but subject to any offset to satisfy any pre-existing debt owed to the United States.³
