ORDER

Robinson has not responded to this Court's August 12, 2016 Order directing him to pay the \$400 filing fee for this action or file a Motion to Proceed in forma pauperis, within thirty days (Doc. No. 3). A copy of the Order was re-mailed to Robinson on August 17, 2016, after the Court received notice of a change in his address (Doc. No. 4). As of this date, however, Robinson has not responded to the Court's Order. Therefore, the Court finds his Complaint should be dismissed without prejudice, for failure to prosecute.¹ Accordingly,
