

ORDER

Hamilton's motions to remand and to strike the notice of removal, *No 11 & 12*, are denied. Ditech's notice said all then-served defendants joined. *No 1 at 4*. All defendants have opposed remand and confirmed consent—in writing. *No 16 & 17*. This suffices under 28 U.S.C. § 1446. *Griffioen v. Cedar Rapids and Iowa City Railway Company*, 785 F.3d 1182, 1188 (8th Cir. 2015). And Ditech's lawyer appeared by signing and filing the notice; no prior separate paper was required.
