JUDGMENT

On September 23, 2019, this case came on for trial before a jury. On September 25, 2019, the jury returned a verdict in favor of Defendant as to Plaintiff's claim for race discrimination and a verdict¹ in favor of Plaintiff on her claim for retaliation, awarding her damages in the amount of $17,036.13^2$ for loss of wages and benefits and $330,000^3$ for other damages. The total amount of the judgment, 47,036.13, will bear interest at the lawful rate⁴ until paid.

The Court will consider Farrar's Petition for Attorneys' Fees and Costs (Doc. No. 81), filed on October 11, 2019, once a response has been filed or the time for response has passed.
