ORDER

For the reasons stated from the bench at the end of trial on 8 July 2021, the Court requests a post-trial motion for judgment as a matter of law from Tanner on the First Amendment issues. Tanner's motion on punitive damages is denied as moot based on the jury's special verdict No. 3.
