ORDER

Before the Court is a motion to dismiss with prejudice filed by plaintiff Alexis Alfaro (Dkt. No. 28). Mr. Alfaro represents that the parties have entered into a settlement agreement (*Id.*, ¶ 1). Mr. Alfaro represents that he has been unable to contact counsel for defendants regarding the motion to dismiss, but Mr. Alfaro maintains that counsel for defendants does not object to the current motion (*Id.*, ¶ 4).
