ORDER

- **1.** Motion to correct, N_{2} 53, denied as moot. The Clerk already filed a copy of N_{2} 47 in Pinney's other case. N_{2} 7 in E.D. Ark. No. 5:19-cv-229-KGB-BD.
- **2.** Motion, $N_{\mathbb{Q}}$ 56, denied. Nothing in Pinney's new papers, $N_{\mathbb{Q}}$ 54–56, indicates that his state criminal appeal has been resolved. This case must therefore remain stayed.
- 3. The Court understands that Pinney believes a stay is inappropriate. But this Court has ruled on the issue; and the United
