### <u>ORDER</u>

The Court has reviewed the Proposed Findings and Recommendations ("Recommendations") submitted by United States Magistrate Judge Jerome T. Kearney (Dkt. No. 20). 5. The Court denies as moot the motion to stay scheduling order (Dkt. No. 21).
