ORDER

1. Vega hasn't paid the filing and administrative fees (\$405) or filed an application to proceed *in forma pauperis*. He must do one or the other by 3 February 2025. If he doesn't, his case will be dismissed without prejudice. LOCAL RULE 5.5(c)(2).

- **2.** The Court directs the Clerk to mail Vega an application to proceed *in forma pauperis* and a blank § 1983 form. If the Court grants him permission to proceed *in forma pauperis*, then the administrative fee will be waived, but Vega will have to pay the \$350 filing fee in monthly installments taken from his prisoner account. 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b).
- **3.** Vega's motion for the appointment of counsel, *Doc.* 2, is denied without prejudice. The case is young and not yet screened. *Plummer v. Grimes*, 87 F.3d 1032, 1033 (8th Cir. 1996).
