<u>ORDER</u>

By Order dated April 21, 2009 (DE #6), this Court granted plaintiff's application to proceed <u>in</u> forma pauperis in this action filed pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The Clerk of the Court shall prepare summons for the defendants and the United States Marshal is hereby directed to serve a copy of the original (DE #2) and amended complaints (DE #8) and summons on defendants in care of the Arkansas Board of Correction and Community Punishment Compliance Division, P.O. Box 20550, Pine Bluff, AR 71612-0550, without prepayment of fees and costs or security therefore.
