
**ORDER**

The Court has considered Magistrate Judge Joe J. Volpe's Proposed Findings and Recommended Disposition—to which Terry Proctor objected—and conducted a *de novo* review of the entire record, including the recording of Proctor's 2 September 2010 pre-jury hearing. Based on this review, the Court adopts Magistrate Judge Volpe's proposed findings and recommended disposition. FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b)(3).

The Court dismisses Proctor's federal claims against all Defendants with

prejudice. Because no federal claims remain, the Court declines to exercise jurisdiction over Proctor's state-law medical malpractice claim against Dr. Suphan. 28 U.S.C.A. § 1367(c)(3) (West 2006). That claim is dismissed without prejudice.
