ORDER

On April 12, 2010, the Court entered an order denying Plaintiff's motion for appointment of counsel (docket entry #23). On May 24, 2010, the Court entered an order denying Plaintiff's motion for injunctive relief, in which he complained about problems with mail, and inadequate medical care at the W.C. Dub Brassell Detention Center (docket entry #42). Now pending is Plaintiff's motion seeking reconsideration of those orders (docket entry #44). Defendants have filed a response indicating that Plaintiff is no longer incarcerated at the detention center (docket entry #54).

Plaintiff has not offered any reason to cause the Court to believe the decision denying appointed counsel should be modified, and now that he is no longer held at the Brassell Detention Center, his request for injunctive relief is moot. Accordingly, Plaintiff's motion (docket entry #44) is DENIED.
