
ORDER

The Court has considered Magistrate Judge Joe J. Volpe's Proposed Findings and Recommendations, *Document No. 25*, and Howard Jones's objection, *Document No. 27*. After *de novo* review, the Court adopts Judge Volpe's recommended disposition as its own. FED. R. CIV. P. 72(b)(3).
