ORDER

Plaintiff commenced this *pro se* 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action alleging that defendant violated his constitutional rights. [Doc. No. 1]. On September 29, 2010, plaintiff was given thirty days to either: (1) pay the \$350 filing fee in full; or (2) file an application to proceed *informa pauperis*, along with a prisoner calculation sheet. [Doc. No. 2]. Plaintiff was advised that the failure to timely and properly do so would result in the dismissal of his case, without prejudice, pursuant to Local Rule 5.5(c)(2). *Id.* As of the date of this order, plaintiff has failed to comply with the September 29, 2010, order, and the time for doing so has expired.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Pursuant to Local Rule 5.5(c)(2), this case is DISMISSED, WITHOUT PREJUDICE, due to plaintiff's failure to timely and properly comply with the September 29, 2010, order.
- 2. It is certified, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(3), that an *in forma pauperis* appeal from this order of dismissal and the accompanying judgment would not be taken in good faith.
